

**EAT YOUR WAY TO \$10K PROMOTION**  
**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1) Information on how to enter and the prize(s) form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- 2) The promoter is AMP Capital Shopping Centres Pty Limited (ABN 13 001 595 955) trading as Karrinyup Shopping Centre of 200 Karrinyup Road, Karrinyup WA 6018 AUSTRALIA telephone 08 9204 9501 (“**Promoter**”).
- 3) Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over.
- 4) This promotion will be conducted at the Karrinyup Shopping Centre of 200 Karrinyup Road, Karrinyup WA 6018 Australia.
- 5) Promotion commences on Saturday 1 June 2019 and ends at Sunday 30 June 2019 (“**Promotional Period**”).
- 6) To enter, individuals must complete the following steps during the Promotional Period:
  - a) Spend at any participating food or beverage retailer listed under item eight (8) at Karrinyup Shopping Centre.
  - b) Present their purchase receipt(s) and provide their telephone number and email address to the Customer Service Desk to enter the draw to win \$10,000 worth of Karrinyup Shopping Centre gift cards.
  - c) Consent to subscribe to the VIP email database at the time of entry.

- 8) Incomplete, indecipherable, or illegible entries will be deemed invalid.
- 9) Multiple entries permitted, subject to the following: (a) each entry must be submitted separately and in accordance with entry requirements.
- 10) Entrants must retain original purchase receipt(s) as proof of purchase. Failure to produce the proof of purchase for all entries when requested may, in the absolute discretion of the Promoter, result in invalidation of ALL of an entrant’s entries and forfeiture of any right to a prize. Purchase receipt(s) must clearly specify the store of purchase and that the purchase was made during the Promotional Period but prior to entry.
- 11) The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant’s identity, age and place of residence) and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these Terms and Conditions, tampered with the entry process or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise fair and proper conduct of the promotion. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter’s discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The Promoter’s legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.

- 12) If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
- 13) The draw will take place at Karrinyup Shopping Centre on Monday 1 July 2019 at 3pm (AWST). (“**Draw**”). The Promoter may draw additional reserve entries and record them in order in case an invalid entry or ineligible entrant is drawn. An entrant does not need to be in attendance at the Draw in order to win a prize.
- 14) The winner will be notified by phone within two (2) business days of the Draw. The winner’s name will be published online at the Karrinyup Shopping Centre website on Wednesday 3 July 2019.
- 15) The Promoter’s decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 16) The first valid entry drawn will win \$10,000 in Karrinyup gift cards, valued at \$10,000.
- 17) The following conditions apply to the prize:
  - a) participants cannot enter receipts from stores in which they are currently employed at in any capacity (including any affiliates of that store); and

- 19) If any prize (or part of any prize) is unavailable, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute the prize (or part of the prize) with a prize to the equal value and/or specification, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority.
- 20) Total prize pool value is \$10,000.

- 24) Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any other implied warranties under the ASIC Act or similar consumer protection laws in WA (“**Non-Excludable Guarantees**”). Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion.

- 25) Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) is not responsible for and excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by a winner or entrant; or (f) taking/use of a prize.
